

COVID-19 Guidance for Essential Businesses and Operations – Food, beverage, and license marijuana production and agriculture

COVID-19 Stay At Home Order

In order to minimize contact among people and stop the spread of COVID-19, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine and Ohio Department of Health Director Amy Acton is ordering all Ohioans to stay home or at their place of residence, effective 11:59 p.m. March 23, except for essential activities, essential governmental functions, or to operate essential businesses and operations. Homes or residences include houses, rental units, hotels, motels, shared rental units, shelters, and similar facilities. The order will be in effect until 11:59 p.m. April 6, 2020, unless it is rescinded or modified before then. For full details, please read [the order](#).

In this order, essential businesses and operations consist of food, beverage, and licensed marijuana production and agriculture. This includes:

- Food and beverage manufacturing, production, processing and cultivation including:
 - Farming
 - Livestock
 - Fishing
 - Baking
 - Other production agriculture, including:
 - Cultivation
 - Marketing
 - Production
 - Distribution of animals and goods for consumption
- Licensed medical marijuana use, medical marijuana dispensaries, and licensed medical marijuana cultivation centers
- Businesses that provide animals:
 - Food
 - Shelter
 - Other necessities of life for animals including:
 - Animal shelters
 - Rescues
 - Kennels
