Rates & Flights

The total OIACI land travel package cost is \$2,500, assuming a double occupancy room; for single occupancy please add \$500. Your flight to and from Israel is not included in our package but we can provide information about booking a flight for your trip. Airlines that schedule direct flights include Delta, United, and Air Canada; however, there are other airlines that fly to Israel with a layover in Europe.

If you wish to meet the group at the airport to catch our bus, you will need to meet us in the Tel Aviv airport on **March 18**, 2018 at 9am. Likewise, if you would like to take our bus back to the airport, your return flight should depart on **March 23**, 2018 at 11pm.
